Seafood -

KAF will not purchase, cook or endorse endangered species.

Wherever possible the KAF Cookery School will purchase locally grown, fished and farmed produce based on low food kilometres that reduce carbon emissions.

Energy -

KAF premises are fitted with 5.2 kW solar panels.

KAF will ensure that to conserve energy all equipment is switched off when not required.

Water -

KAF premises water is sterilized without the use of chemicals. Installed Silver impregnated water filter system and R500 14w Ultraviolet Water Sterilizer.

Cleaning -

KAF will use biodegradable products where biodegradable products are available.

Recycle -

KAF will purchase and use any recyclable products that are not harmful for the environment.

KAF will recycle incoming packaging that is not at risk of containing harmful bacteria.

Waste -

KAF will minimise and dispose of waste in a safe and responsible manner.

KAF will encourage suppliers to raise or adhere to its environmental standards.

KAF will make all employees and students/customers aware of this policy.
